SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Assists the Assistant Pastor (Elementary) with the planning and preparation of the acquired small group curriculum for the weekend services. This includes organizing activities and games for the weekend elementary environment.

The incumbent must perform all job duties as outlined in this job description to support ongoing mission of the church while committed in accordance with the *Baptist Faith and Message (2000 edition)*.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Assists with the planning and preparation of activities and games for the weekend elementary small groups. (app. 45%)
- Assists with the coordination of small group leaders, greeters, and check-out volunteers during the weekend services. Coordinates the check-out process in the 252 Theater and monitors the exit doors during weekend services. Assists with recruitment of volunteers. (app. 40%)
- Organizes and distributes the curriculum to volunteers. (app. 5%)
- Assists the Assistant Pastor (Elementary) with planning and setting goals for the small group ministry. (app. 5%)
- Assists the Senior Administrative Pastor with KidzWorld events, such as Baby Dedication, KidzWorld FX, and summer camp activities. (app. 5%)
- These duties are subject to change as church needs and strategies evolve. Employee may be required to perform other duties.
